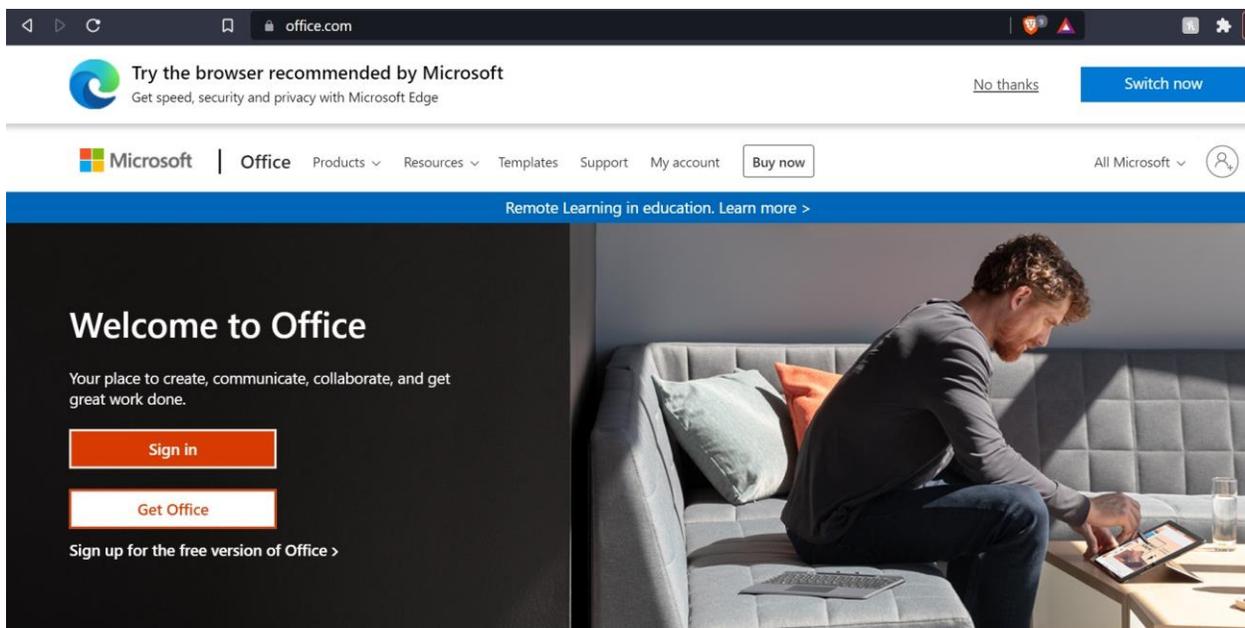


Activating MFA on your account

Multi-factor authentication (MFA) is a process where a user is prompted during a sign-in event for additional forms of identification. When we require a second form of authentication, security is increased as this additional factor isn't something that's easy for an attacker to obtain or duplicate.

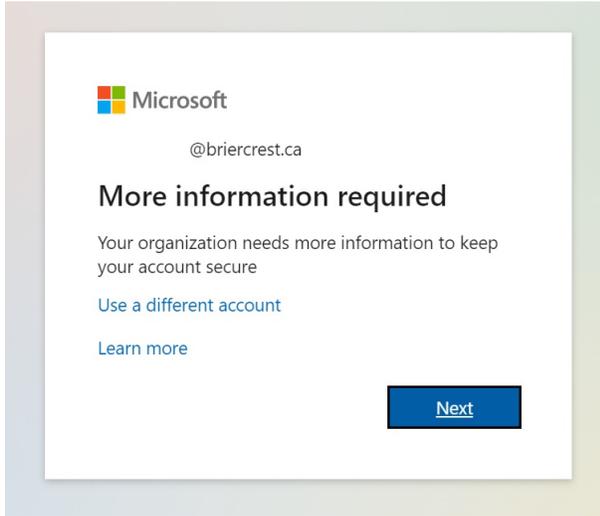
Step 1:

Browse to www.office.com in any internet browser (Edge, Chrome, Firefox, etc) and sign in with your Briercrest account and password (orange button on the left). If you are already signed in, skip to Step 2.



Step 2:

This message indicates that we're about to setup MFA. Click Next to continue.



Step 3:

Enter your information as required and click Next

Step 5:

Your account setup is finished. Microsoft provides a password for you to use with applications on your computer that connect to Office365 without using MFA (Outlook, OneDrive, Skype). Keep it handy because you'll need it if you use these applications. You can save it to a document on your computer, take a picture, or write it down.
